

Environmental Policy



Scope and Context

The Environmental Management System (EMS) at Pritex Ltd. covers the testing and conversion of foam, fibre, and associated materials for the automotive, industrial, and furniture sectors at its Wellington manufacturing site.

The EMS applies to all site-based activities, products, and services, including relevant support functions (maintenance, warehousing, and administration) that can influence environmental performance.

It excludes activities outside the organisation's operational control; however, outsourced processes and the supply chain are considered where they can be influenced.

The needs and expectations of relevant interested parties, including employees, customers, suppliers, contractors, regulators, and the local community, are considered.

In establishing and maintaining the EMS, Pritex Ltd. considers relevant internal and external issues that may affect its environmental performance, including legal, technological, economic and environmental conditions.

Policy Commitment

Pritex Ltd. is committed to protecting the environment, preventing pollution, and fulfilling its compliance obligations. Environmental management is an integral part of our business strategy and operations.

We recognise our responsibility to protect both the environment within our site and the surrounding ecosystem, and to operate as a responsible and trusted neighbour.

We are committed to the protection of the environment, including the prevention of pollution, sustainable resource use, climate change mitigation, and the protection of biodiversity and ecosystems.

Environmental Objectives and Improvement

Pritex Ltd. will implement, maintain and continually improve an Environmental Management System in accordance with ISO 14001.

We will enhance environmental performance by:

- Reducing waste to landfill and increasing reuse and recyclability
- Improving energy efficiency and reducing carbon emissions
- Monitoring and reducing water consumption
- Preventing pollution to land, water and air

Environmental objectives and targets will be established, monitored and reviewed regularly, with performance evaluated at least annually.
